



# Gérard Chaput

## EXPERIENCE

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Born in Bizerte (Tunisia) in 1949, he graduated in Physics and Medicine. He specializes in neuroanatomy and neuropsychology.

From 1972 to 1977, he was an assistant at the Faculty of Medicine of Montpellier in an INSERM research laboratory - and research associate at the CHU Montpellier Nîmes Hospitals. From 1977 to 2003, he worked as a medical doctor, particularly for women and children who were victims of violence, and as a reservist in the Army Health Service for operational units.

In 2003, he joined the active military service and became a senior medical officer for the benefit of gendarmerie units and special forces. His research focuses on the assessment of individual vulnerabilities in crisis and chaos situations and the accompaniment of operational staff in managing stress in intervention.

Since 2005, he has been a lecturer at the Faculty of Medicine of Paris V and the Kremlin Bicêtre Paris XI and at several military schools (St Cyr Coetquidan, St Astier, Ecole d'application du Génie, ENSOSP, ENAP, etc.).

In 2011, he became assistant physician ("R") of the General Medical Inspector of the Army Health Service and contributed to the development of policies for the prevention of Psychosocial Risks.

During his military career, he has received numerous honours: Knight of the National Order of Merit, National Recognition Medal - External Operations, Campaign of the Former Yugoslavia Medal, National Defence Medal and NATO Medal.
